## BOOKING FACILITIES

The theatre booking office is open daily (excluding Sundays) from 10 a.m. until 8 p.m.

Telephone bookings can be accepted on Folkestone (0303) 52466 and will normally be held for Patrons until half-an-hour before the curtain time on the day of the performance.

Postal bookings should be addressed to the Leas Pavilion Theatre, The Leas, Folkestone, and, **please**, accompanied by a stamped addressed envelope. Alternatively, in the absence of an envelope, the tickets will be held in your name for collection at the booking office.

## SEASON TICKETS

We have now introduced a SEASON TICKET SCHEME for regular theatregoers which represents a considerable saving on the price of your seats. Season ticket holders are able to see NINE productions for the price of only EIGHT!!

This means in effect that you pay £10.00 for a £1.25 seat season ticket and save the full £1.25 over the nine productions of your choice.
